Granting Permanent Status to Employees Recruited to Government Institutions, Corporations and Statutory Boards on Temporary, <u>Casual, Substitute, Contract and Relief Basis</u>

Your attention is drawn to the Public Administration Circular No: 21/2006 dated 06.12.2006 and other Circulars issued as amendments to the above Circular.

- 02. Government has decided to grant permanent status to the following employees serving as at 30.06.2008 on temporary, casual, substitute, contract and relief basis with effect from 01 07 2008
 - (1) Employees who have completed the 180 days upto 30.06.2008 and satisfied the qualifications prescribed in the Public Administration Circular No: 21/2006 dated 06.12.2006 amended by Public Administration Circular 21/2006 (III) dated 07.04.2008.
 - (2) Employees who have completed a continuous satisfactory service of not less than 03 years upto 30.06.2008 and training of not less than 03 days as mentioned in Public Administration Circular 21/2006 (I) dated 17.07.2007 even if they have not satisfied educational qualifications stipulated in the schemes of recruitment of the relevant post.
- 03. Further, Sri Lanka Vocational Training Authority is hereby included to the list of institutions indicated in the Circulars issued previously as recognized institutions for training.
- 04. Employees who have not received the relevant training by 01.07.2008 should be provided such training before 30.09.2008 and they should be granted permanent appointments with effect from the date of completion of the training.
- 05. Additional allocations will not be provided by the General Treasury for payment of salaries in 2008.
- 06. Other provisions indicated in those Circulars shall further remain unchanged.
