Imposing punishments to the accused officer when such officer is found guilty under Sub Section 24:3, Chapter XLVIII, volume II of the Establishments Code, at the formal disciplinary inquiry

Your attention is hereby drawn to Sub Section 24:3, Chapter XLVIII, volume II of the Establishments Code. The Cabinet of Ministers has decided at its meeting held on 09.11.2011 to revise above Sub Section with the inclusion of following Sub Sections.

- When the accused officer is found guilty at the formal disciplinary inquiry, an amount of Rs. 30,000/- shall be recovered by not more than 24 installments in the implementation of punishments which are relevant to Sections from 24:3:3 to 24:3:13 except punishments imposed under Section 24:3:1 or 24:3:2 as the disciplinary order given against him.
- 24:3:15 In case where the accused officer fallen under 24:3:1 and 24:3:2 is reinstated in service with a punishment or sent on retirement after making appeals against the disciplinary order, Rs. 30,000/- in 24:3:14 above shall be recovered from the officer concerned.
