Revision of Section 22, Chapter XII of the Establishments Code

Your attention is drawn to Section 22, Chapter XII of the Establishments Code.

02. It has been decided at the meeting of the Cabinet of Ministers held on 09.05.2013 to revise the

Establishments Code with the inclusion of provisions of granting no- pay leave for an illness of a child

or the spouse of a public officer, immediately after Sub Section 22:7 of Section 22.

03. Accordingly, Section 22, Chapter XII of the Establishments Code is revised with the inclusion of

2 new Sub Sections as 22:8 and 22:8:1 after Sub Section 22:7 of the Section 22 in the following

manner.

22:8 No - pay leave to be spent in or out of the island shall be approved for a maximum period

of one year on the recommendation of a consultant at a government hospital, for

treatments due to an illness of an unmarried child or spouse of a public officer.

22:8:1 In case where both mother and father are public officers, only one officer shall be

allowed to obtain leave as per above 22:8 above.
