| Subjects                  | Duration | Maximum Marks | Pass Marks |
|---------------------------|----------|---------------|------------|
| Subject Related Knowledge | 3 hours  | 100           | 40         |
| Intelligence Test         | 01 hour  | 100           | 40         |

*Note :-* The Intelligence Test paper should be a common paper for all the Departments and the Subject Related Knowledge paper should be a question paper prepared in accordance with the syllabus set out in the recruitment procedure of each Department. The examination is conducted by the Department of Examinations.

##### 11. Appointment to Posts

11.2 *Method of Selection :-* Selection shall be made to the posts in Grade I on the seniority and merit by a Board of Interview appointed by the Public Service Commission. The qualifications to be satisfied for the posts in each Department should be incorporated in the relevant Recruitment Procedures.

*Note :-* The marking scheme for seniority and merit of the officers, approved by the Public Service Commission will be published at the time of the calling of applications.
